



Financial Agreement

DENTAL INSURANCE:

Because an insurance policy is an agreement between the patient and the insurance company, **we cannot guarantee any estimate of coverage.** In the event insurance does not pay, the patient is responsible for all remaining charges. We are happy to file the forms necessary for you to receive full coverage benefits.

We will wait for estimated insurance payments for 30 days from the date of treatment. After that time we require the remaining balance to be paid in full. We will still make all reasonable efforts to help you obtain your full benefits. In the event an account is sent to collections, the patient agrees to pay all court costs, attorney fees, collection costs and office expenses incurred.

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

Cash or Check We offer a pre-payment courtesy for treatment paid in full prior to treatment. Additional information and limits upon request. There is a \$25.00 returned check fee.

Credit Cards For your convenience we accept payment by MasterCard and VISA.

Payment Plans Patients may be eligible for in-office financing. We will work closely with you to customize a plan to suit your needs. We also offer payment plans through Care Credit.

Patient Co-pay Patient's estimated portion is due the day of service. Every attempt will be made to give accurate estimates, **however the final amount will not be determined until the claim has been processed by the insurance company.**
